### Minutes:

1. The present staff members were informed that the ISR syllabus is approaching its three-year cycle, thus it will soon be undergoing a review. The lecturers were informed that upon the conclusion of the lecturing duties, an attempt to increase

the frequency of meetings will be made. This will be done for the sake of consultation amongst ISR lecturers, in attempt to provide constructive feedback and suggestions in order to improve the content being presented to the students.

2. The revision of the syllabus will also see the formulation of new learning outcomes, accompanied by concise assessment criteria modelled by Bloom's Taxonomy. Assignments will be devised in accordance to fit the proposed Application assessment criteria.
3. Rather than a one size fits all approach, assignments are also intended to be devised in accordance to the students' ability. Assignment tasks will be verified by the verifiers before they are presented to the students.
4. The ISR staff were also notified that following the meeting on 7.2.18, the majority of the lecturers agreed to opt for a 50% global passmark. Although this decision was not welcomed by all staff members, the vast majority were in agreement, and thus the cover sheets will be modified accordingly.
